

Minutes of the Middletown Parks and Recreation Committee for October 19, 2010.
Present were Tony Ventre, Chairman, Lewis Corl and Pam Dietrick.

- Alexander Cook attended the meeting to provide us with a brief status update of his Eagle Scout project for the Wiles Branch Park. The Committee members shared with Alexander their concern about the placement of the fire pit and other items. We requested that he provide us with his proposed locations for review. He was also advised to touch base with Bruce Carbaugh regarding his project.
- The Committee would propose that an additional trash can of similar style as those that already in place in Wiles Branch be purchased and placed next to the basketball court.
- The Committee provided two play equipment catalogues to Drew with a selection of two play equipment items to be placed in the Wiles Branch Park play ground. Drew was asked to get pricing information for the pieces selected.
- Lewis Corl continues to work on the grant for the Save Trails to Schools program. He is currently gathering information regarding the demographics of the Middletown Schools including the number of students who walk, ride, etc.
- Pam Dietrick has agreed to take over the lead with regard to the pond restoration project in Wiles Branch North.
- Chairman Ventre will contact Dr. Messersmith to see if he has any written materials that can be placed on the Parks website for review by those who may be interested in his presentation.
