

Minutes of the Middletown Parks and Recreation Committee for September 21, 2010. Present were Tony Ventre, Chairman, Lewis Corl and Pam Dietrick.

- The Committee conducted a final review of the power point presentation to be displayed at the Town tent during the Heritage Festival. In addition, the committee prepared its brochure for distribution.
- The Committee reviewed the location drawings for the Billotti play area in Memorial Park including the proposed sign. Chairman Ventre on behalf of the Committee solicited clarification Cassandra Billotti at the Sept. 27 Town meeting as to the play area's exact location and size.
- Lewis Corl advised the Committee that the State of Maryland has available through its safe routes to schools program \$3million in grant money. Lewis will under take the arduous task of filling out the multi-page application with the hope that we can garner some grant money for the completion of the walking trail to the primary school.
- The Committee further discussed having Dr. Donald Messersmith, PhD. Professor emeritus at the University give a talk on bird watching and bird habitat. However, the Committee would like to gauge what kind of community interest there would be for such a presentation before having Dr. Messersmith commits his time.
