TOWN MEETING MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING

April 23, 2012

The second monthly meeting of the Burgess and Commissioners of Middletown was called to order on, April 23, 2012, by Burgess John D. Miller at 7:00 p.m. in the Middletown Municipal Center, 31 W. CONSENT AGENDA

Snodgrass – Mrs. Snodgrass was instrumental in the Town obtaining the Municipal Building and worked diligently as a Delegate to get funding. By general consent the Board agreed to name the meeting room *Louise V. Snodgrass Meeting Room*. A dedication will be scheduled sometime in May.
