Did you know that there are multiple ways to get up to date information on things happening within Middletown? Keep reading for ideas on how to receive emergency notifications, meeting agendas, town event information, etc...everything you may need to stay on top of town activity.

1.) www.middlestown.md.us

This is the town website. You will find anything and everything going on in the town on that site. Our community calendar, news and announcements, community events, the town business directory and so much more! It is a treasure trove of information.



2.) Email Notifications & Alert Frederick

Sign up for Middletown Email Updates and/or ALERT Frederick robocalls. It is quick and easy and will keep you current on events and issues affecting our town.



On your phone go to the town website, www.middlestown.md.us. Scroll down and click on the yellow "Citizen Connect" button.

For Middletown Email Updates: enter your name and your email address. Please check any of the 4 topics listed that you would like to receive email updates about. At a minimum check "Other news". Then click the "submit" button.

For ALERT Frederick robocalls: click on the yellow "Citizen Connect" button. Scroll down past the Middletown Email Updates information and click on the "ALERT Frederick County" button. You will be prompted to create a username and password. Be sure to click on Middletown, MD when prompted to click on those things you want information for. ALERT Frederick County is a county initiative.

If using your computer or iPad, the yellow "Citizen Connect" button will be on the top right of your screen on the Town's homepage. Alert Frederick will be on the bottom left of the Middletown Email Updates page.
